THE J. BARNEY KUENNEN FAMILY

THE KUENNEN'S OF ST. LUCAS -

There is a long tradition of friendship and intermarriage between the Bodensteiner and Kuennen families. The two patriarchs, Gerhard Heinrich Kuennen and John Carl Bodensteiner were friends and neighbors. Gerhard's son, Herman Henry, married John Carl's sister, Theresia, and the two couples were sponsors for each others' children. More inter-marriages between the two families will be seen in the following brief history.

The Kuennen family first came to this country in 1850, according to the Fayette County History of 1878. They had lived near the little town of Lastrup, in the district of Oldenburg, Germany. For two years they lived in Pennsylvania, then for two years they lived in Indiana, before coming to St. Lucas in 1854.

That first family consisted of Gerhard Heinrich and his children: John Henry, John Gerhard, Anna Maria, Maria Angela, John Wessel, Herman Heinrich and John Bernard. The wife and mother, Maria Anna Tinnerman Kuennen, did not come with them. We can presume that she died in Germany. John Gerhard has no records in this country. Family tradition has it that a Gerhard died at sea and was buried at sea. This must be John Gerhard. They frequently used the middle names. So the grandfather of Herman Kuennen of St. Lucas is remembered as Henry. The grandfather of Leonard Kuennen, also of St. Lucas, is remembered as Barney, or J. Barney. The grandfather of Ray Kuennen of Lawler is known as Wessel.

Following are the birth dates of those who left for the USA, according to the Lastrup church records:

John Henry Kuennen - 1817 John Gerhard Kuennen - 1820 (Anna) Maria Kuennen - 1824 (Maria) Angela Kuennen - 1836 (John) Wessel Kuennen - 1830 (Herman) Heinrich Kuennen - 1834 (John) Bernard Kuennen - 1837

A male child was born and died on the same day in 1832. These dates above all match the dates given to me by relatives in the USA. They also match official records here, so I'm sure that they are correct.

I would now like to tell a few facts about Gerhard and each of his 6 children:

Gerhard died October 17, 1881, so there is no one alive who remembers him personally. However, some do remember their parents talking about him. The late Sister Beata Mihm told that Gerhard used to walk to St. Lucas every day to ring the noon Angelus. Often a grandchild would walk with him. She said that his son Henry continued that custom when he was elderly. Gerhard could not write, but made this mark when he sold land.

The late Frank Kuennen told his son Leonard that Gerhard and J. Barney dug a well across from the present Leonard Kuennen farm. This would be the Will Kuenner farm today. The matter came up because the threshers were trying to set the machine in that field when one of the big wheels dropped into the hole. Then J. Barney remembered that they had dug an old well in that spot.

From Gerhard, we will focus our attention on John Henry, also known as "Prairie" Kuennen. He lived on the prairie, while St. Lucas was built at the edge of the timber. John Henry was the first Kuennen to buy land, in 1854, and he farmed 47 acres one mile west and a half-mile north of St. Lucas. His log cabin was set

far back into the field. His wife, Catherine Eckholt, died in 1874 at the age of 68. Their only daughter died about the same time, and the son-in-law joined a religious order of men in Wisconsin. When his neighbor, Adam Martin, was killed in a wagon accident in 1875, John H. bought some cattle from his widow Barbara, and helped her with some of the work. They were married in 1876, but sadness came again to Barbara, as John Henry died just three years later, in 1879. Barbara Balk Martin Kuennen, of course, was the sister of Margaret Balk who married John Carl Bodensteiner. Barbara eventually went to live with her daughter Theresa and her son-in-law John H. Kuennen. This John H. was the son of Henry (or H. H.) Kuennen. The farm is presently owned by Daniel Kuennen.

The next oldest child, according to the Lastrup church records, is <u>Anna Maria</u>. There is no positive record of her at St. Lucas, but a Mary A. Kuennen married John Meyer, and she was born in 1824. This must be her. This Mary and John Meyer lived south of the Daniel Kuennen farm, on the present Joe Hageman place. Their children were: Katherine - married Henry Meyer; Mary - married William Schrandt; Caroline - Sister Constantia; Henry - married Mary Schmitt; August - married Mary Untereiner; Barney - married Katherine Martin; Elizabeth - married Theodore Hageman; and Anna and Joe who remained single.

Maria Angela was known as Angela, and she married Gerhard Hackman, Sr. in 1850. They lived, died and were buried in Decatur, Indiana. Several of their children came to St. Lucas. The young men helped their Kuennen uncles on their farms. Their daughter, Anna Hackman, married Christ Schmitt of Fort Atkinson. Gerhard married Theresia Bodensteiner, daughter of John Carl Bodensteiner. (For their family group see pages 36 - 43.) Herman married Johanna Bodensteiner, another daughter of John Carl. (For their family group see pages 106 - 111.) (Theodore) Joseph Hackman married Magdalena Meyer.

John Wessel Kuennen became known as "Old J. W.", and his wife was Mary Bucheit. Their children were Anna - married August Hageman; Joe - married Catherine Schmitt; Henry - married Mary Boeding; Nick - married Mary Reicks; and John W. - married Catherine Croatt. Julia died in infancy. Wessel died in 1899, and Mary died in 1930. They are buried in St. Lucas. A large family has descended from John Wessel, and they have printed a family tree.

Herman Henry became known as Henry (or H. H.) Kuennen. The history of the Archdiocese of Dubuque states that he was the first teacher at St. Lucas, in 1855. He bought the present Daniel Kuennen farm in 1859, and offered to give 40 acres for the new church in St. Lucas. This is the land where the new Herman Kuennen house now stands. But a group from the town of St. Lucas wanted the church closer and made an offer, which was accepted by the pastor. Henry did plant the trees and shrubs around the parish grounds. In his old age, he walked each noon to ring the Angelus bell, and his grandchildren walked with him.

The story is told about Henry, that he would take up the collection at Mass and many times the total collection was less than a dollar. To stir up some action, he tied a bell to the bottom of the basket, and if the giving was hesitant, he would shake the basket under their nose and the bell would ring.

Henry was very interested in education and served on the school board for many years, as did his son, John H. Henry was also great at planting orchards. His favorite apple tree was a "Peerless" variety, and his grandchildren nick-named him "Peerless". In his old age, he enjoyed walking downtown to the store, and visiting around the cracker barrel. He died at the age of 85, in November of 1919, at his home with John H. Kuennen.

At the age of 27, Henry married Theresia Bodensteiner, the sister of John Carl. A son, and a daughter, were born to them but both died. Theresia, herself, died at the age of 21. (For their story, see page 133.)

Henry then married Gertrude Steffes in 1864. Their children were: Margaret - married Clemens Mihm; John H. - married Theresa Martin; and Theresa - married Carl Martin. Gertrude died in childbirth at the age of 25 in 1870, and the infant died and was placed in the casket with her.

Henry's third wife was Cecelia Foreman. They were married in 1871, and their children were: Louis - married Ida Kuether of Minneapolis; Henry (Hank) remained single, lived in St. Paul; Sophie - married Harry Martin of Pittsburg, Pennsylvania; Magdalene - Sister Edwina, OP; and Ben H. - married Mary Perry.


Some of Ben and Mary Kuennen's descendants are still at St. Lucas, and they include Kenneth Kuennen, who married Lorraine Bodensteiner. Lorraine is a great-granddaughter of John Carl Bodensteiner, also a great-granddaughter of J. Barney Kuennen; Kenneth is a great-grandson of Henry Kuennen.

(Editor's note: Father Denis is also a descendant of both Kuennen and Bodensteiner patriarchs. His father, Leo, is a great-grandson of Gerhard Heinrich Kuennen, and grandson of Henry. His mother, Elizabeth Kuehner Kuennen is a great-granddaughter of John Carl Bodensteiner, also the great-granddaughter of Maria Angela Kuennen Hackman.)

The youngest son of Gerhard Heinrich Kuennen was J. Barney (1837 - 1911). He married Catherine Meyer, and they farmed south of St. Lucas, on the present Leonard Kuennen farm. He was known to go far and wide to buy and sell horses. He usually would attend morning Mass before he would go about his business. He was a musician, and played the organ in church. He also had a small organ that was portable and he would carry it on his back. The children of Barney and Catherine were (See pages 1 - 1 for their family group): Helena - married Henry Bodensteiner (for their story see pages 44 - 86); Anna - married Clemens Schmitt; Mary - married Henry Schmitt; Frank - married Elizabeth Kuehner; Caroline - married Herman Boeding; and Catherine - married Joseph Blong.

The descendants of Gerhard Heinrich Kuennen who came to this country with six children, number in the thousands. It is hoped that this brief history of those seven people will stir the memories of the reader, and encourage more accounts of our good ancestors and their lives in Church and community.

Great-grandparents Barney and Catherine farmed just south of St. Lucas, the farm now owned by their grandson, Leonard Kuennen. Catherine died at the age of 48, and Barney made his home with his son Frank, who farmed the home place. For several years, he lived on the south edge of St. Lucas, having moved an old country schoolhouse from Auburn. This later became the buttermakers' house, just across from the creamery. When Barney's health began to fail, Frank persuaded him to come back to their home. The day before he died, Barney walked to each of his five daughters' farm homes to visit.

Like great-grandfather Bodensteiner, great-grandfather Barney also played the organ in church. In fact, he carried a small portable organ and walked with it to the Old Mission church, in the days before St. Lucas had a resident pastor. He was known far and wide as quite a horse-trader.

What we know of Catherine's family, was found by another great-granddaughter, Clementine Schmitt Kinkor of Calmar, who has been studying censuses, wills, probates and other records. Catherine's father, Casper (also known as Kepper) Meyer, was born on 12 Oct 1804 in Germany, and died 16 Sep 1872 in St. Lucas. His wife was Mary Elizabeth, born in 1807 in Germany. It is believed they came to Iowa in 1851. In the 1856 census, their children are listed as John, 15; Catherine, 12; Dina, 1; Casper Henry, O. In Casper Meyer's will, the family is listed as "wife Elizabeth", and the children in a different order: "son Casper Henry, daughter Katherine, daughter Dina, and son John F. (or H.) Meyer". The younger Casper married Lydia A. Vizein, John Meyer married Maria Catharina Kunnen, and no further mention of Dinah has been found.

Barney and Catherine had at least eleven children, five of them died in infancy. These five additional names were found in church records. Some of these tombstones are still identifiable on our cemetery.


